If a shooter finishes as an event Champion or Runner Up, that shooter will be awarded the higher purse between the event purse and class purse in the class in which he shoots. The event purse will then be passed to the class winners. Class purses will be split 60%/40% if there are five or more shooters in the class, otherwise the class winner will take 100% of the class purse.

Ties and Shoot-offs: All ties will be shot off by shooting doubles at station 3 – 4 – 5. Miss and out by station. NSSA rules will govern. Shoot-offs will commence following completion of the last rotation of the day.

This shoot is sanctioned by the NSSA, whose rules will govern. All shooters must be members of the NSSA and all New Mexico residents must be members of the NMSSA.

Chaparral Skeet Club reserves the right to change the program at anytime without recourse or protest.

Non-classed shooters may NOT enter Class Purses unless declaring into Class AA

Sub-Junior, Junior and Collegiate shooters have the option to shoot for Honors only. A \$31.00 entry fee per event will apply.

Shoot is limited to the first 30 Shooters

Drinks and Lunch will be provided for Shooters on Saturday and Sunday.

Protests: Referee's decision on all questions of fact will be final. All other protests will be referred to the Protest Committee.

Liability: Spectators and contestants assume all risks of accidents.

Ammunition: Please bring your own ammunition because none will be sold at the shoot.
