### 2 Discussion

2.1 **Financial.** Brock presented a "Statement of Financial Position" dated 10/6/22 showing a total bank account in the amount of \$69,930 and a "Statement of Activity" for 2022 showing a total income of \$67,303 and a total outgo of \$61,376 which equals a net operating revenue for the current year of \$5,927.

2.4 **Skeet.**

2.4.1 The final Club Skeet Shoot will be held on Sunday 10/30/22. It is a 100 bird event and you must have completed 3 previous monthly events (150 birds) to be eligible. Cost to enter is \$44.00. Immediately following will be lunch along with the awards ceremony.

2.4.2 All skeet machines are working good. Kendal has two machines in Roswell on which he is performing the periodic maintenance.

2.5 **Trap.**

2.5.1 The Noons Lions Club shoot was on 10/1/22. There were 15 squads that shot approximately 3,750 birds. An invoice was sent to them in the amount of \$1,500.

It was a great success. However, there were some things we could have done to make it run more smoothly;

- 1) When squads increased to 15 we should have opened the "P" field.
- 2) Needed more volunteers. Scorekeepers worked 4 hours without a break.
- 3) Volunteers needed to be assigned duties.
- 4) Needed runner to shuffle score cards to and from scorekeepers.

## 2.8 Facility Grounds Care

2.8.1 Toilets need serviced. The toilet on the west end of the parking lot is broken at the seat and the door on the one at the sporting clays range is broken. Phillip has notified the Parks and Rec and will follow up with them.

2.8.2 Our public address system is not working. Rick has borrowed a PA system from the 4H to use during the John and Joe Memorial Shoot. He has also spoke with a communications company. They will come out and repair our system. Rick's goal is to have it done within the next 2-3 weeks.

2.9 The LCPD is trying to take over the eastern portion of the Butterfield Range to make a dedicated shooting range just for them. This would wipe out our sporting clays range, 5 stand and any future trap fields. Phillip met with Cindy Pollock last week and toured all ranges together. We agreed that the LCPD need to utilize land that is currently not being used on the far West end of the range. She will arrange a site meeting with City Parks and Rec.

2.10 The John and Joe Memorial Shoot is 10/8/22.

1. We will shoot trap and skeet. Flash targets have already been loaded in Trap Fields #1 and #2 along with Skeet Fields #1 and #2. Each participant will be allowed to shoot two rounds of their choice. A token will be awarded for each flash target broken.

2. A long range sporting clays bird will be set up on trap field #3. Each person gets 3 shots. If you break all 3 you win a token.

3. Flag Maintenance. Rope was replaced. Thank you Mark Parmeter.

4. Phillip mounted the John and Joe Plaque.

5. Rick read his speech. Sounds very nice for both John and Joe.

6. Melody Pruet, Sheila Gardenhire and Stephanie Allison will handle the lunch. The lunch will be free.

7. Scott will organize the Salute shoot on "P" field.
