Purse payout and options the same as the Preliminary Event

EVENT 4 28 Gauge Championship 100 Targets, \$60.00*

Awards: same as EVENT 1.
Purse payout and options the same as the Preliminary Event

EVENT 5 .410 Bore Championship 100 Targets, \$60.00*

Awards: same as EVENT 1.
Purse payout and options the same as the Preliminary Event

EVENT 6 HOA Championship 400 Targets, \$15.00

Shot concurrently with Events 2, 3, 4, and 5. HOA class can be no lower than the competitors lowest gun class. Competitor must enter Event 6 to be eligible for HOA concurrent awards and the NMSSA HOA awards.

Awards: same as EVENT 1 with E Class added.
Purse payout is the same as the Preliminary Event

EVENT 7 Champion of Champions 100 Targets, no entry fee

Open to all NMSSA members in good standing. Based on shooters score for the last 25 targets of Events 2, 3, 4, and 5.
Award: NMSSA Plaque to Champion

EVENT 8 John Moen HAA Championship 500 Targets, \$15.00

Shot concurrently with Events 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.
Purse payout is the same as the Preliminary Event

CONCURRENT EVENTS, no entry fee

Shoot-offs for Events 4 – 8 and the concurrent events will be held after the completion of Event 5.

THREE-MAN TEAM CALCUTTA, \$10.00 per person

Concurrent with Event 4 (28 ga.): Split 70% Team Buyer, 30% Team Shooters. Teams will be determined by the Skeet Manager Software Program, based on the combined average of the team members, making the teams as equal as possible. Calcutta bidding will be held after Saturday night dinner. Ties will divide payout.

Payout:

1 to 5 entries	100
6 to 10 entries	60/40
11+	50/30/20

This shoot is sanctioned by NSSA, whose rules will govern. All New Mexico residents must be members of NMSSA. NMSSA reserves the right to change the program at any time without recourse or protest.

If a specific event has more than 40 entries before August 1st, a third rotation will be added (Max 60 Shooters). This may result in a time change for all rotations that day.

A drawing will be held for entrance fees into the 2023 world shoot for 4-gun shooters that wish to attend the 2023 world shoot who have never been to a world shoot. Please let shoot-management know if you are interested.

Ties and Shoot-offs: All ties will be shot off, no long runs. Doubles at stations 3 – 4 – 5 for all events except HOA Champion. All shoot-offs, miss and out by station. NSSA rules will govern.

Ties for NM HOA Champion will be shot-off by shooting a regular round of skeet with the .410 Bore, with the high score winning. If no winner has been determined after one round of regular skeet, the shoot-off will proceed to doubles at 3 – 4 – 5.

Referees: Referees will be paid \$0.07 per target. Anyone interested in being a referee, contact Brad Thompson at (575) 247-1313

Protests: Referee's decision on all questions of fact will be final. All other protests referred to the Protest Committee.

Liability: Spectators and contestants assume all risks of accidents.

Ammunition: No ammunition will be sold at the club during the shoot. No proofs will be provided.

Practice Rounds: \$6.00 each. Club will be open for practice at 8:00 am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Meals: Lunch and drinks are included Saturday and Sunday for all competitors.
