2.0 Financial

2.1 Financial. "Statement of Financial Position" dated 10/3/23 showing a total bank account in the amount of \$59,058 and a "Statement of Activity" for 2023 showing a total income of \$50,840 and a total outgo of \$64,991 which equals a net operating revenue for the current year of (\$14,151). Our account dipped approximately \$20K, due to target payment in September. We accidentally overpaid for the September shipment of targets by approximately \$4,000. Brock said that we received the \$4K refund check from our supplier and it is not yet included in the statement numbers noted above.

4.1 The Cowboy Church Trap Shoot was held on 9/9/23. All went well and Brock said they already paid. They paid cash the day of the event.

4.2 The Noon Lion Club shoot was on 9/30/23. Jerry said there were approximately 80 shooters. We utilized all 5 trap fields. There was confusion about who provides the score keepers and also the lack of a computer program to handicap after the first round. These issues will be resolved before the next shoot.

4.3 A trap instructor, Phil Kiener was here on 10/2/23 and 10/3/23 to instruct the kid shooting teams. Preston said they threw over 120 rounds of trap.

8.2 MVSS will rent a table at the upcoming Sunrise Lions Club Gun Show on 10/21 and 10/22/23 located at the Las Cruces Convention Center. We will need 4 volunteers to man the table. We still do not have the volunteers required. We may have to leave the table unmanned and just leave a stack of fliers. Millers Guns & Ammo (Jason Browning) offered us a table at no charge. Jimmy will have a 6' banner made up with our logo. He was given a \$297 check during the meeting to pay for the banner. We will need 8.5x11 information handouts along with our business card to hand out at the show. We will see if Joe Pfeiffer can help get those designed/printed.

8.3 MVSS needs a riding lawn mower. Not to exceed \$5K. To be discussed in the board meeting following this meeting.

8.4 Lead reclamation - Jason Browning is taking on this issue. Thank you Jason! Phillip forwarded all emails to him regarding the subject. Hopefully he can reach an agreement with the city/BLM.
