

Ties for HOA Champion will be shot off by shooting a regular round of skeet, with the high score winning. If no winner has been determined after one round of regular skeet, the shoot-off will proceed to doubles at 3-4-5.

Referees: Referees will be paid \$0.07 per target. Anyone interested in being a referee, contact Brock Hammond (575) 644-3608

Protests: Referee's decision on all questions of fact will be final. All other protests referred to the Protest Committee consisting of William Ponder, Tom Christopher and Keith Sparks.

Liability: Spectators and contestants assume all risks of accidents.

Ammunition: No ammunition will be sold at the club during the shoot. No proofs will be provided.

Practice Rounds: \$6.00 each. Club will be open for practice at 7:15 am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
